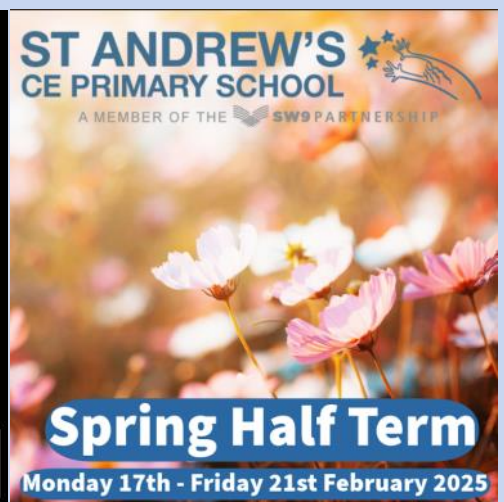

## School uniform


Parents and carers are reminded that full school uniform should be worn at all times unless the school informs you otherwise.

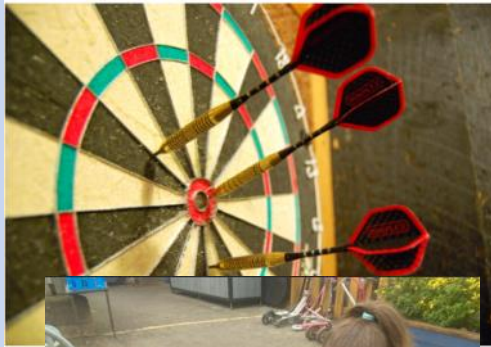
